#### **AVID Success:**

So far this year, **13 of the 34** AVID students have already been accepted to a total of **23 schools** with **scholarships** and grants **totaling \$366,240**!

We expect all three of these numbers to grow by a very large amount in the coming weeks and months.

## **Course Offerings News:**

Next year, FCHS will offer 27 of the 33 AP courses available within FCPS and 2 of 3 dual enrollment (DE) courses. These include three new offerings: Art History, Computer Science, and Comparative Government. This is the 2nd largest number of AP/DE offerings in the county (second only to Westfield that offers 30).



### **AP Testing News**



% of Total FCHS AP Students with a Score of 3 or Better - as compared to the state and nation

### 25% of all 2013 FCHS graduating seniors received Advanced Diplomas

Advanced Diplomas are based on AP performance. For the Class of 2013 (Class size of ~350):

- 45 AP Scholars (13% of graduating class scored 3 or higher on three or more AP exams)
- 16 Scholars with Honors (5% of class averaged at least 3.25 on all AP exams taken and scored 3 or higher on <u>four</u> or more AP exams)
- 23 Scholars with Distinction (7% of class averaged at least 3.5 on all AP exams taken and scored 3 or higher on five or more AP exams)
- 2 National Scholars (average score of at least a 4 or more on all AP exams and a score of a 4 or higher on eight or more of those exams). Seven students of the Class of 2014 are expected to achieve AP National Scholars!

Of particular note, is the AP Calculus AB exam

• The whole group pass rate was 94% (second highest rate in FCPS - TJ was first)

# Orchestra Achievements

FCHS placed 18 orchestra students on the District X Junior and Senior Orchestras. This is the highest percentage of any school auditioning for these select spots.

# **Sports Achievements**
